



# English Language Immersion Programs

## Summer 2017

### 1. Program description

Since 2005, we have welcomed children from all over the world during the summer in our ESL (English) Programs. We have designed a format that integrates field trips and different encounters to help them with their conversation skills. For Example we had a wonderful opportunity for our young students to meet Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin, the second man who landed on the moon, while he was in Los Angeles. It was an amazing experience for the children... The students had prepared some questions and got to ask a few of them.

A typical day would look like this (activity varies with the age group):

#### 1. 9 am to 12 pm - Morning Language Class:

- First part of the class
  - Review vocabulary/syntax needed for new material
  - Introduction of new material via role play, communicative activities, games
  - Role play and practice
  - Second part of the class
- Activity: for example interviewing adults or other children of the same age, going to a restaurant to order food, going to the farmers' market ... the idea is to create real life communicative activities for the student to practice understanding and ability to speak.
- Third part of the class: individual instruction to allow each student to work on their specific challenges
  - We focus our curriculum to any part of the language the students need to improve.

#### 2. 12 to 1 pm - Lunch:

- Students who stay for the afternoon activities will be able to eat lunch (provided by the family) at Savoir Faire

#### 3. 1 to 4 pm - Afternoon field trips:

- We organize fun and/or cultural field trips in the afternoon.
- Local students join us for these outings to allow your child to meet American children
